pastoral council minutes

The meeting opened with scripture reading, reflection and prayer.

- 1. MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 28, 2007: Reviewed and accepted as written.
- 2. CHURCH FAMILY ALBUMS PRESENTATION: David Wade from PCA International, the holder of Church Family Albums, gave a presentation on what his company had to offer for a parish directory. He shared samples from other parishes showing the various formats and bindings available. The basic layout includes an introductory page, activity pages, formal parishioner pictures, directory listing, and optional memorial/ad pages. PCA will require a minimal number of parish volunteers and will be responsible for all rescheduling, taking of photos, and providing a sample letter to parishioners, bulletin write-up and displays for sign-up and scheduling. Two volunteers for each Mass will be needed for parishioner sign-up and completion of the appointment cards.

General Procedure:

- a) Parishioners are notified by letter, bulletin and during Mass.
- Sign-up dates are made available for parishioners to schedule photos.
- c) PCA will be responsible for sending reminders, rescheduling sessions and collecting information to be put under each photo.
- d) The parish decides what additional types of pages to include such as pictures, history, cover, binding and number of copies.
- e) Homebound parishioners will be able to submit pictures for inclusion.
- f) Each family/individual will receive one 8x10 photo with the option of purchasing additional copies and a copy of the directory. Volunteers will receive a discount on any additional photo purchases.
- g) As a gift, the company will compose and present to the parish a large mosaic of all of the photos or in lieu of the mosaic, 20 small pocket sized directories. Additional pocket sized directories may be purchased.
- h) In addition to sign-up volunteers, a few volunteers will be needed to assist with the final formatting.

- Once all photos, decisions, and formatting are complete, the proof will be ready within 15 working days and the final directory within 20 working days.
- A contract was entered into and signed by Fr. Stan, pastor, with PCA. The following schedule was agreed upon.
- Week of 5/21 letters to be sent to parishioners regarding the directory.
- Tuesday, 5/22 meeting of the sign-up volunteers at 7pm in the parish library.
- m) Photo scheduling sign-up each weekend in June.
- n) Photos to be scheduled for July 11, 12, 13, 14 and August 8, 9, 10, 11 at Sacred Heart.
- o) Format committee meetings to be determined.

3. 50TH ANNIVERSARY REPORTS:

- a) Banquet: Lionel presented the contractual agreement for Maneeley's. It includes table setup, cash bar, date and time of banquet, and menu choices. The menu choices include a chicken, beef and seafood entrée as well as a special child's meal. Each of the tables will seat approximately ten persons. The banquet is set for Sunday, June29, 2008 with a final head count due on Friday, June 20, 2008. A signed copy of the agreement and non-refundable deposit is due by Friday, April 20, 2007. There was brief discussion by council members regarding the terms of the contract and list of invited guests. The council agreed to accept Maneeley's terms. Father Stan signed the agreement which will be returned with the deposit by Lionel. Table mementos are yet to be decided.
- b) Children's Activities: Report not available.
- c) Gardens and Grounds: Volunteers are still needed. A notice will be placed in the bulletin.
- d) Speakers: Father Ed Dempsey has not been contacted as he is still away. No report available regarding Mike Stacy. Bishop Cote will be the homilist at Mass and Bishop Hart will be requested to give the blessing at the banquet.
- e) Invitations: Carol White shared sample invitations with the council. Cost is based on size, type of paper, print used, and number of pieces for each invitation. Carol recommended a four sided single invitation with a perforated RSVP section that can be easily separated and returned leaving the invitee with the section containing needed information regarding the banquet. Carol will meet with Ruth to develop a draft for council members to review.
- 4. <u>NEW MEMBERS:</u> Fr. Stan has requested that the 2007 off-going members remain on the council another year for continuity of the 50th anniversary celebrations. The off going members have agreed to serve another year. Three new additional members will still be added with six members leaving the council in 2008.
- 5. <u>PLANNING:</u> The council briefly discussed future planning and review of parish goals.
- 6. ITEMS FOR NEXT AGENDA: 50^{TH} Anniversary reports, new members, banquet invitation draft.
