1. MINUTES OF APRIL 11, 2007: Accepted as written.
2. 50TH ANNIVERSARY REPORTS:
 - a. Children's Events: Matt reported that there is a vendor in Springfield, Ma. who has several types of "bounces" and a dunk tank for rental. The price includes delivery, set-up, and take-down. The dunk tank rental fee is \$190.00. After brief discussion, council members agreed that Matt contact the vendor and obtain more detailed information regarding deposits and actual types of bounces available. The children's events were set to coincide with the Coney Island Picnic date of June 8, 2008. Matt will also look into the "fishing hole" and see what is available for items on orientaltrading.com.
 - b. Directory: The following parishioners have volunteered to help with scheduling photo sessions for the directory: Carol Duhamel, Sandy Rice, Maureen Staggenborg, and Donna Valli. Additional volunteers are still needed in order to cover all of the Masses for the month of June. A meeting of the volunteers will be held May 22nd at 7PM.
 - c. Speakers: Matt reported that Mike Stacy would be willing to attend the next council meeting to discuss our request for Mike to be the banquet toastmaster. Father Stan has notified the Bishop's Office regarding our request for the Bishop to be the homilist at Mass and will be speaking with Father Dempsey regarding our request for Father Dempsey to be the banquet guest speaker.
 - d. Invited Guests: Father Stan reviewed with council members the invited guest list compiled thus far. The list includes former parish priests and Bishops.
 - e. Gardens & Grounds: Thus far there is one volunteer who has volunteered to care for the gardens in front of the office building. More are needed. There will be a meeting on May 22nd for all who are interested. Matt shared a request by the youth group to paint a mural on the outside building wall of the fellowship room rather than repaint it in a solid color. After brief discussion, council members agreed that it would be a wonderful contribution by the youth group.
 - f. Invitations: Carol and Ruth met to discuss and draft a sample banquet invitation. Carol presented a sample choice of white or cream for the invitation with the drawing on the front by Brother Michael from our parish mission. Council members agreed on cream which will fit in with banquet coloring and Brother Michael's drawing for the front of the invitation. Rella will obtain clearance on using the drawing. The invitation will be a four sided single sheet invitation with an RSVP tear -off for the entrees, date and time of the

banquet, and directions to the facility. Invitations will need to be finalized by early winter of 2008.

3. FRANK RUNYEON PRODUCTIONS: Rella shared that one of the many informational mailings that she receives was one from Frank Runyeon Productions. Frank Runyeon travels throughout the country putting on one person shows lasting approximately 35 minutes each. Two of the productions are Sermon on the Mount and Hollywood vs. Faith. Rella asked if the council would be interested in having Frank Runyeon Productions come after Easter of 2008 as part of our 50th celebration. The productions involve providing a spotlight and an optional hymn before and after by the attendees. The cost is \$1,000 - \$2,000 depending upon whether there are other engagements in the area and lodging availability. However, this cost is flexible and Frank Runyeon Productions is willing to work with the parish. After brief discussion, council members requested that Rella follow-up on details, availability, and if there are any other bookings in the area which would help to defray the costs.
4. NEW MEMBERS: Requests for new member nominations will be made this upcoming weekend. Father Stan will contact each nominee for willingness to serve. Members will be chosen on Pentecost.
5. YOUTH WORLD DAY: There are six youths interested in attending Youth World Day in Sidney, Australia in 2008. An informational meeting was held. Parents will need to make a decision and provide a deposit for the trip. Father Stan and additional adults will attend as chaperons.
6. WHAT HAVE YOU HEARD?: Ordination of Deacons will be in June. This will be the last class for some time. The program has been suspended by the Bishop.
7. NEW BUSINESS:
 - a. Books: Carol White would like to donate Chuck's books to the parish to be used as resources for parishioners. Council members accepted Carol's offer and thanked Carol for her generosity and thoughtfulness. The books will be placed in the library with a sign-out system for those wishing to borrow any of the references.
 - b. Disciples in Mission Sign: The sign will be taken down and redone to reflect Sacred Heart's 50th anniversary and service to the Vernon-Rockville community. The installation ceremony will be in June, 2007.
